Safety Procedure SO-06-010

TO: ALL MEMBERS
FROM: SM Donald Pond, Safety Officer
RE: VEHICLE SORTIES ON HIGHWAYS
DATE: 1 October 2006

Any ground sortie(s) that require our team members to be on roads or highways, including the shoulder or on/off ramps, must wear an approved reflective safety vest (Day or Night) when exiting the vehicle. The vehicle must have its warning device turned on (four way flashers, and if equipped, a yellow rotating beacon or strobe light that is visible 360 degrees).

When a CAP owned vehicle is not in motion and the driver has exited, one wheel shall be chocked.

There are no exceptions to this procedure.
